Exterior Home Protection Checklist

Notes:

Outside the home, small actions can prevent major damage.

- Secure roof sheets, awnings, and loose panels
- Clear gutters/drainage to prevent water buildup
- Trim branches close to the house
- Secure outdoor furniture, pots, and tools
- Check gates, fences, and perimeter walls

Interior Home Protection Checklist

Notes:

Inside the home, focus on water, power, and valuables.

- Elevate appliances/electronics where possible
- Move important items away from windows
- Place documents in waterproof containers
- Unplug non-essential electronics
- Know where your main electrical switch is

Documents & Records

Notes:

These are often forgotten (and hardest to replace).

- IDs, titles, contracts
- Insurance policies and receipts
- Emergency contacts
- Digital backups (photos or cloud storage)

Before Conditions Worsen

Once warnings become severe, **movement and decisions become harder**.

This checklist is meant to be completed **early**, so families can focus on safety rather than last-minute tasks.
